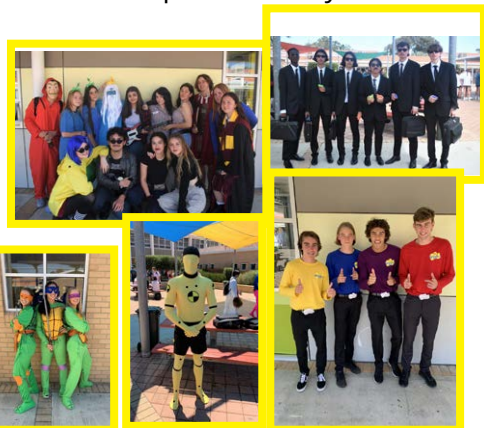
Congratulations

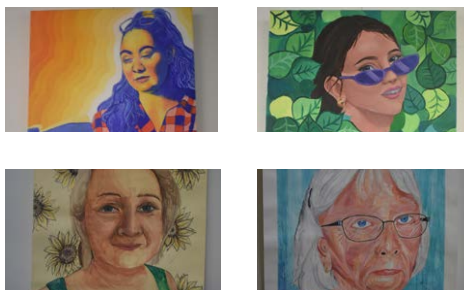
COVID-19 Vaccination Program for students aged 12 and above

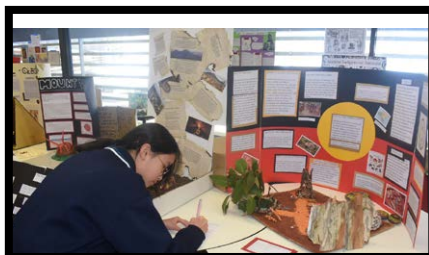
Year 12 Visual Arts Exhibition

This series is classified as Matured Accompanied (MA15+) and children under 15 should not watch MA15+ material unless they are in the company of a parent or adult.
