UWA Year 8 Discovery Day for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Students

Seven of our Year 8 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students attended a full day excursion at the University of Western Australia on Wednesday, 13 November.

This experience introduced students to the university environment through a diverse range of hands-on activities at different departments on campus. The students had a lot of fun exploring athletic ability testing in sports science, some daring chemistry experiments whilst others harnessed their creativity with some screen printing in fine arts.

#### Science Formative Assessment

#### Example: Year 8 Science

In a Year 8 Science class on ecosystems, the teacher used a visual check-in strategy to elicit evidence of student learning during a lesson on food chains and food webs. Midway through the class, students arranged a set of cards representing different organisms into a food web, explaining their choices to a peer. While circulating, the teacher asked targeted questions such as, "What happens if this organism is removed?" to gauge understanding and identify misconceptions. This process provided the teacher with valuable evidence of student thinking. Students then received immediate feedback and follow-up questions to clarify their understanding before moving on with the lesson.






#### **Congratulations**
