





ORIENTATION DAY

Your child's specific orientation day is outlined in your welcome email, your child will be placed into a group of Year 6 students. They will be guided around the school by Year 9 student leaders.

The program for the day will be as follows:

- Parents to arrange transport to school for their child. Year 6s may use the school buses to come to school. A timetable for the school Special Bus Routes can be found on the Transperth website.
- All students are expected to wear their **primary school uniform**.
- All students are to come equipped with pens and pencil case.
- Start time is 9.00 am. All students to assemble in the Concert Hall.
- Orientation Program in class experiencing the high school timetable.
- **Recess** Students may want to bring some morning tea and/or money to use in the school canteen at recess time.
- **Lunch** A sausage sizzle will be provided free of charge. If your child is vegetarian, there will be options for them. If they have any other food allergies it will be a good idea to send them with a packed lunch.
- Finish time 2.45 pm for Year 6s. Parents are asked to arrange transport home for their child at this time.
- The early close will give parents coming to the school for the first time an opportunity to avoid the traffic congestion.

HOUSE INFORMATION

Your child will be allocated a House whilst at Churchlands SHS. You will be advised of your child's House later in the term. A House Coordinator will support your child from Year 7 through to Year 12. Once Year 7 commences, any queries or concerns you may have about your student should be directed to the House Coordinator.



UNIFORM SHOP

New students at Churchlands SHS are required to be fitted for the school uniform. Part way through Term 4 the main Administration will send you an email explaining the process for the booking of individual appointments. These appointments will be on designated days in November and specifically for all new students. It is important that your child attend the booked appointment to ensure the correct sizing of the uniform.

SMARTRIDER

An application for the Student SmartRider card can be downloaded from the Transperth website and taken to your student's primary school for verification. 
Download the Flexischools App
