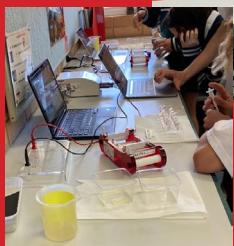




## What's happened

### Gel Electrophoresis Year 12 Biology

Year 12 Biology students were busy in prac lessons learning about Gel Electrophoresis. Students were required to separate mixtures of DNA, according to molecular size. They did this by separating the molecules and pushing them by an electric current through gel that contains small pores.

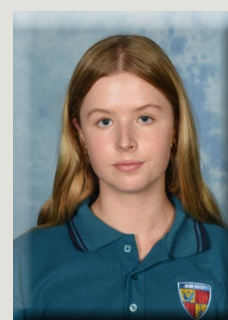

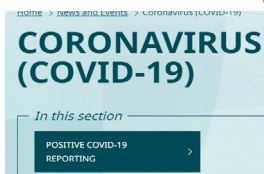
