

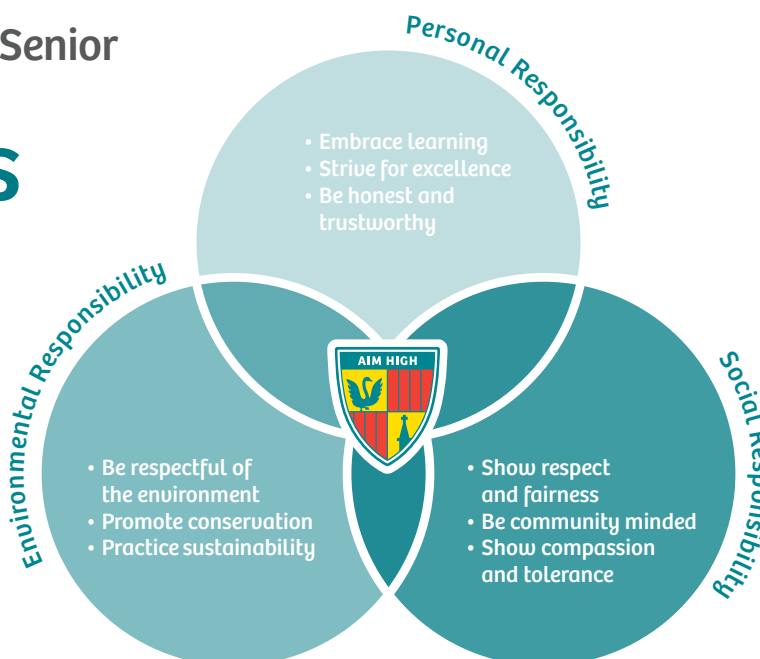

Outstanding Record of Academic Excellence

Our school has an established outstanding academic record. Former students have excelled academically. In 2009 Churchlands ranked 6th in the Western Australian's League Tables. Our 2009 Beazley Medal recipient, Hayley Anderson and the 2008 Runner up for the Beazley Medal, Quan Lau, were graduates from the school's first two intakes into the Academic Extension Program.

Opportunity

We offer an intellectually stimulating education program which is rigorous but supportive, inclusive but flexible and conducive to the pursuit of excellence. Students are challenged by an accelerated and differentiated curriculum that values higher order thinking and critical literacy in a student centered learning environment.

Your child will be welcomed into our learning community which reflects the diversity of the world beyond the school gate. Students can elect to access our global networks including formal ties with schools in France, China and Japan; contribute to the wider community through our internationally awarded environmental education program or participate in various sporting and cultural activities.

Growth

The program brings together like minded, highly academically capable students, fostering the development of their talents as well as caring for their social and emotional needs.

Balance

Our uniquely flexible program is available to students in Years 7, 8, 9 and 10 and operates in two streams - a Maths and Science stream and an English and Humanities & Social Sciences stream. Students may access one or both streams depending on their academic needs. This aspect of the program differentiates it from the Department of Education and Training's affiliated GATE program.

Selection

Selection into the Churchlands Academic Extension Program is based on the results of a selection test which is conducted at Churchlands Senior High School.
