Just a reminder to put these events in your calendar if you are in the marching bands or in the memorial band.

Memorial Band – Sunset Service April 24 – Leaving school at 1515 dressed in your marching band uniforms. King’s Park by 1600 – finish at about 1730 at which point the band members are their parent’s responsibility.

Marching Bands – Meeting in your designated places (TBA) on St George’s Terrace by 0800 on April 25, marching band uniform, instruments (no cases), and concluding on the esplanade around 1100 at which point the band members are their parent’s responsibility.

Driveway bugle call – something to consider on Anzac Day at 0600. Mr Robinson has done this each Anzac Day morning since 2020 (He even got filmed! 🤖) – He lets his neighbours know and most of the street turn out and stand on their driveways with lit candles. You can perform it on any instrument.

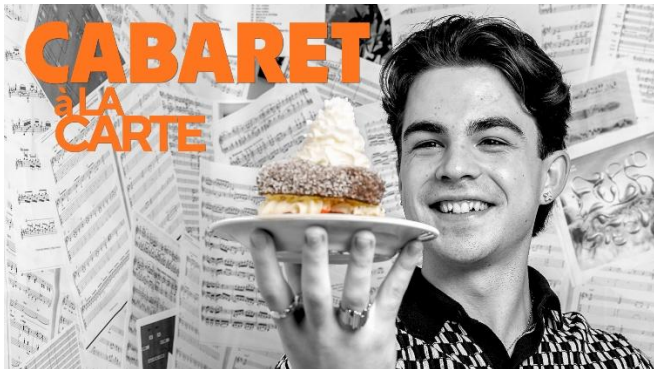
