For those students that had missed out on having their school photo taken, they can do so on the photo catch up day on Thursday 7 March.

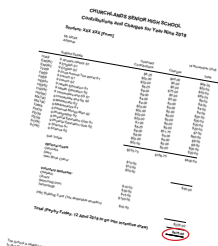
