Nationally Consistent Collection of Data for School Students with Disability

Students are not to have aerosol cans (such as deodorant) at school. If a student is seen with one, the item will be confiscated by a staff member. Parents are requested to remind students about this.

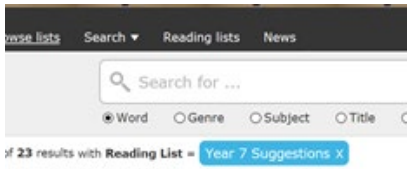


CSHS Library

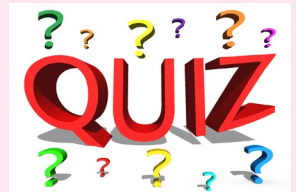
