eRIDEABLES POLICY

1. POLICY STATEMENT

Churchlands Senior High School does not permit students, other than Year 11 and 12 students, to store e-Bikes and e-Scooters on school grounds.

2. POLICY SCOPE

Under current Western Australian Law all e-Bike and e-Scooter riders must be over 16 years of age and wear a helmet when riding. Using this as a guide only, the school, for ease of management, will apply the following conditions:

1. Only Year 11 and 12 students can store eRideables on school premises.
2. All e-Rideables are to be stored in either of the school locked bike compounds.
3. Students choosing storage in the bike compound near the pool are not permitted to ride these on school grounds and must manually wheel these until they are off the premises.

3. DEFINITIONS

- eRideables include, but are not limited to, e-Bikes, e-Scooters, e-Skateboards, e-Wheels, hoverboards, e-Unicycles and e-Skates. It does not include motorised wheelchairs.
- An e-Bike, or electric bicycle, is a bicycle equipped with an electric motor and/or battery that assists the rider when pedalling.
- An e-Scooter or electric kick scooter is **an electric motorised scooter** – a stand-up scooter powered by an electric hub motor in its front and/or rear wheel.

4. PROCEDURES

- 4.1 A student who breaches the policy will have their e-Rideable confiscated and handed to the Associate Principal. This will be documented on SEQTA with the parent/care giver notified. The device can only be collected by a parent or caregiver.
- 4.2 A second breach of the policy will result in a loss of Good Standing. A third breach of the policy will result in a suspension and loss of Good Standing.
- 4.3 A student using an e-Rideable contrary to the above rules who causes injury will be immediately suspended.
