ART AT CHURCHLANDS

In the email please include the title of the artwork, the medium, the size in centimetres, the price and the name of the artist. Please make it clear which photograph goes with the details of the artwork you provide.

THE EXHIBITION

The exhibition is open to all artists whether emerging, professional or student. There is no theme required for entry and the Art Committee is calling on artists across the community to present works of excellence from varied media and practices including painting, drawing, photography, collage, ceramics, sculpture, glasswork, textiles and jewellery.

DELIVERY DATE

The delivery date is Saturday 20th May 2017 from 10.00am to 2.00pm at Churchlands Senior High School Visual Arts Centre off Memory Place, Churchlands. Please note that no late submissions will

be received after this deadline. On delivery, please provide a one or two page CV including photos of your artwork that you are exhibiting. For Churchlands Senior High School students ONLY the delivery deadline is Monday 22nd May 2017.

DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

All works must be clearly labelled and ready to exhibit. All 2-D artwork must be ready for hanging with 2 x D-rings or hanging cord attached. Labels must be placed on the **back** in the lower right hand corner for clear identification.

Display plinths and cabinets will be provided for 3D, ceramics, glasswork and jewellery but any special display requests or equipment will have to be discussed with the Chairperson.

Artists working in 2D and 3D can submit a maximum of 3 artworks, which should not exceed 1m x 1.2m each. Artists making jewellery or other small series can submit UP TO 10 PIECES ONLY TO FIT A MAXIMUM DISPLAY AREA OF 1M X 1.2M. If you are submitting more than three artworks, please use enough entry forms to provide the details of each artwork.

All artwork must be the original work of the artist not previously exhibited at Churchlands. The Art Exhibition Committee has the right to refuse artworks.

FEES

There is a flat rate hanging fee payable of \$15 per artist, regardless of media. The Churchlands Senior High School P&C will retain a 20% commission on all sales at the exhibition. Please ensure that the sale price placed on artworks includes the 20% commission.

DONATIONS TO CHURCHLANDS SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL P&C

If you would like to donate an artwork to Churchlands Senior High School P&C where 100% of the proceeds go to Churchlands Senior High School P&C, please write donation on the Entry Form and the painting will be sold at a silent auction with no reserve price.

COLLECTION OF ARTWORK

Please collect any unsold artwork on Sunday 28th May 2017 between 4.00pm and 4.45pm.

LOSS AND DAMAGE

All reasonable care will be taken in the handling of submitted work. However, no responsibility will be accepted by the organisers for the loss or damage of artworks. **It is recommended that artists take out suitable insurance.**

INVITATION TO OPENING EVENT

The Community Art Exhibition at Churchlands Senior High School has been a very successful event over the years with each year hosting unique works created by artists within Churchlands and the broader community.

We will be hosting an opening event at 5.30pm on Friday 26th May 2017.
