# Year 9 and 10 Compulsory Courses

- i) English, Mathematics, Science and Humanities and Social Sciences. Four periods each per week.
- ii) All Year 9 students study two periods of Languages per week. Students must continue with the Language studied in Year 8: French or Japanese. For Year 10 students Languages is optional.
- iii) Two periods of Physical Education per week or two periods of Special Sport (Football, Netball or Swimming).
- iv) One period of Health Education per week.

# Career Pathways

What is happening for our students?

They:

- Begin to specialise in curriculum areas
- Are making more decisions and therefore may feel increasing pressures.
- Increase their thinking about future (with mixed emotions)
- May be aware they have limited experiences, and still have a lot to learn.
- Are broadening their experiences with the workplace, through part-time or casual employment

## Career Development

- ✓ Career development is the **ongoing process** of **managing life, learning** and work over the lifespan.
- ✓ It **applies to everyone**: children, adolescents and adults!
- ✓ **Career Development is a vital element of the lifecycle** as it assists people to **navigate their way** through education and training into employment and **fulfilling working lives**.
- ✓ The world-of-work is **changing**, so this is an **exciting** time for young people with many opportunities to explore.

  - ✓ **Adaptability**
  - ✓ **Integrity**
  - ✓ Capacity for **lifelong learning**



# Career Pathways

Making choices is hard!

- Encourage students to start exploring career options...it's never too early!
- If a student is eager to do specialize by undertaking ATAR courses, then exposure in Middle School is to these courses is encouraged, but not compulsory.
- It is important that Year 8 and 9 and subsequently Y10 students maintain high grades if they wish to do ATAR courses in Year 11 and Y12.
- All year 8 and 9 students this year will complete a Department of Education individual pathway planning booklet through form class.

Digital Literacy elective → Applied Info Tech Cert II → Cert IV in Cyber Security at TAFE

# Year 9 Elective Courses

- i) Students will have two selections for each semester (FOUR for the year) and will choose TWO reserves for each Semester.
  
- ii) Students needs to choose **at least ONE** subject from **The Arts** and **at least ONE** subject from **Technologies** (over the year).

*All Music courses are included as an Arts course and STEM is included as a Technologies course.*

# Year 10 Elective Courses

- i) Students will have three selections for each semester (six for the year) and will need to choose TWO reserves for each Semester.

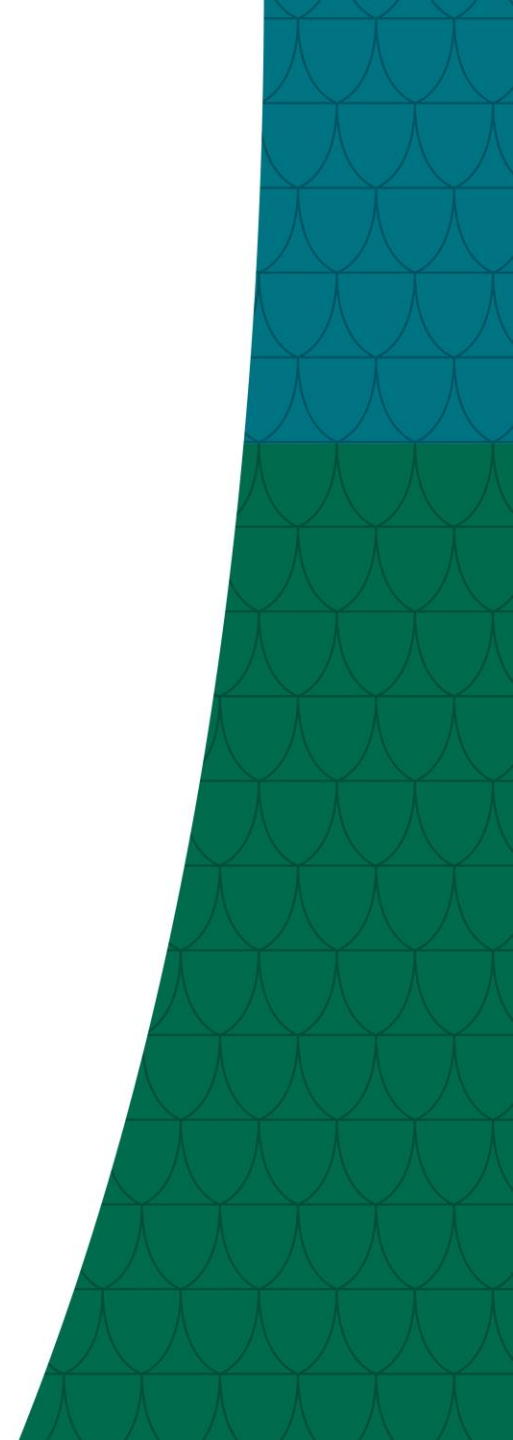
*Please note: Year 10 GATE Music students will not need to select a Technologies course!*

- ii) Students needs to choose **at least ONE** subject from **The Arts** and **at least ONE** subject from **Technologies** (over the year).

*All Music courses are included as an Arts course and STEM is included as a Technologies course.*

# GATE music students

- Music students who want to do outdoor education may need to have their selections entered manually
- Music students who do specialized sport can pick general HPE as well if they want to
- Language is compulsory for Y9 but not in Y10.



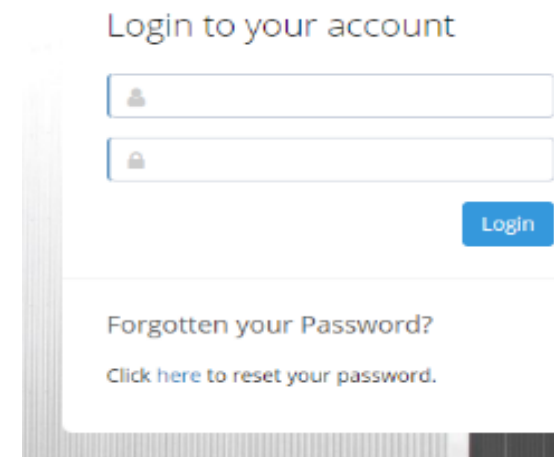
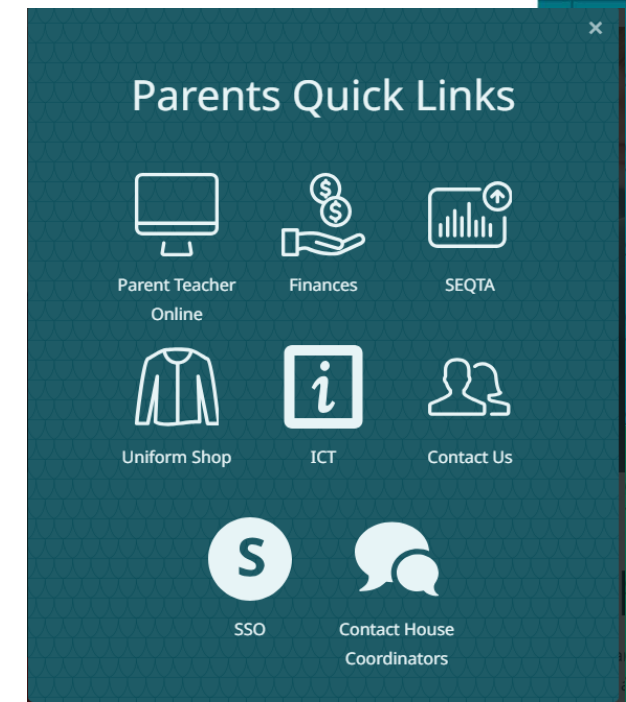
# Log on information

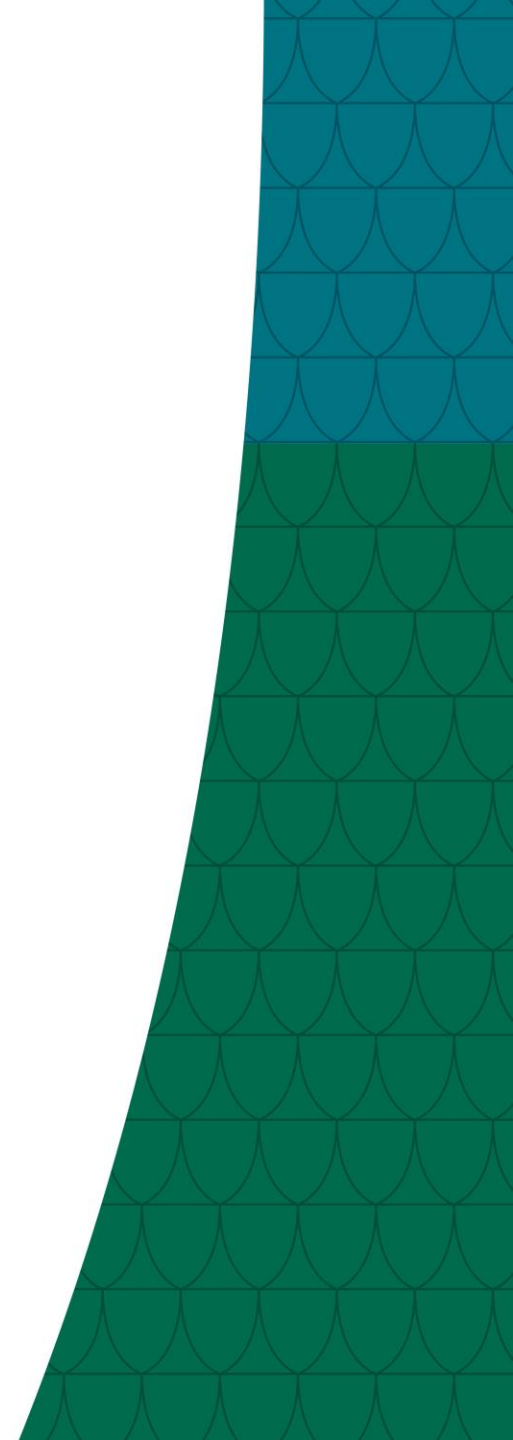

- 1. Access the SSO site. [Access SSO](#)
- 
- 1. The way you begin your access to the SSO site is using your email address as the username and then by clicking on the **“Forgotten your Password?” link. The system may take 15 minutes to generate the password.**
- 
- 1. Click on the “Forgotten your Password” link to reset your password. You will need to enter your registered email address. When you submit this, if you have more than one child involved, it will ask you which child you wish to change the password for. If the correct email address has been entered, an email will be sent to you with a login code (copy it) and a blue link to login and reset password. Click on this link, select your own password to use for SSO and enter twice. Click on the blue Change Password link and it will take you back to the login screen. Once here, enter the login code (**which you copied from the email**) and your new password and you should be in.
