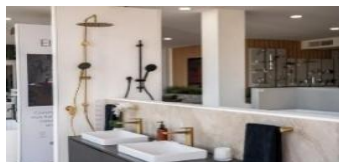
★ The Music Department for running the gamut of roles from facilities manager to door usher to parking attendant to bottle toss adjudicator and more!
