




Australian Tertiary Admission Rank

Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR)

- Rank position in the total WA Year 12 school leaving age population
- 75.00 means you have performed better than 75% of all the Year 12 school leaving age people in WA

Calculating the ATAR

- Tertiary Entrance Aggregate (TEA)
- TEA = best 4 scaled scores

 + 10% of a Language Other Than English
 + 10% of Maths Methods and Maths Specialist
- Maximum TEA = 430

Educational Access Scheme


If you have experienced educational disruption in Year 11 and/or 12, for example due to health issues, family violence or financial circumstances, you can apply for consideration under the EAS.

Online Application

- Login with User ID (WACE number) & password
- Answer all questions
 - Remember to enter any VET qualifications
 - Enabling courses (eg UniReady, OnTrack, TLC Learning for Tomorrow, UniPrep) need to be added under the university question.
- Upload documents now or later
- Insert Course Preferences (codes)
- Declare all is True and Correct

Your application is not active until you've made the declaration and paid.

Online Application - things to look out for

- Don't forget your qualifications we're not mindreaders
- Supporting documents
 - Additional submissions TISC will email you
- Don't use a school email address!
- Please provide at least one phone number, preferably a mobile phone.

Payments and Direct Applications

- Flat application fee of \$80 no late fee
- Once this fee is paid, you can apply through TISC and/or apply directly to one or more of the five universities
- Not all courses will accept direct applications
