

Laptop BYOD Program




SEQTA



ORIENTATION DAY

Your child's specific orientation day is outlined in your welcome email, your child will be placed into a group of Year 6 students. They will be guided around the school by Year 9 student leaders.

The program for the day will be as follows:

- Parents to arrange transport to school for their child. Year 6s may use the school buses to come to school. A timetable for the school Special Bus Routes can be found on the Transperth website.
- All students are expected to wear their **primary school uniform**.
- All students are to come equipped with pens and pencil case.
- Start time is 9.00am. All students to assemble in the Concert Hall.
- Orientation Program in class experiencing the high school timetable.
- **Recess** Students may want to bring some morning tea and/or money to use in the school canteen at recess time.
- **Lunch** A sausage sizzle will be provided free of charge. If your child is vegetarian, please email Ms Paula D'silva at **pdsilva@churchlands.wa.edu.au**. If they have any other food allergies it will be a good idea to send them with a packed lunch.
- **Finish time 3.00pm** for Year 6s. Parents are asked to arrange transport home for their child at this time. The remainder of the school will continue with normal timetable until 3.15pm.
- The early close will give parents coming to the school for the first time an opportunity to avoid the traffic congestion.

ORIENTATION CAMP

The 2022 Year 7 Orientation Camp will be conducted during Week 5 of Term 1 (28th Februray – 4th March) at Ern Halliday Recreation Camp, Hillarys. The Year 7 Camp is designed to challenge students through a variety of adventure and initiative activities. The activities will challenge the students both physically and mentally and are designed to reinforce the individual skills of coping, independence, self-management, as well as team work and leadership. Activities will be conducted by staff from Ern Halliday Recreation Camp, in conjunction with staff from Churchlands SHS. These specialised instructors have been employed to conduct activities where specific skills and knowledge are required. On all occasions, a staff member from Churchlands will be in attendance to supervise the activity.

Students are expected at school no later than **9.00am** and will meet on the grassed area in front of the Science building for roll call. They are not required to be in school uniform. Transport to and from the camp will be by bus. Please arrange to collect your child at **3.00pm** or make arrangements for them to get their own way home.

The cost of the camp is \$155 per student and this includes:

- Accommodation
- All meals (except morning tea the day they arrive)
- Bus to and from the camp/school
- Activities

Students will be required to bring their own morning tea on the day they arrive. Time will be allocated for this break on arrival at Ern Halliday.

Please make payment by <u>Wednesday 1 December 2021</u> via the schools 'Qkr' app on iPhone, iPad or Android. Please follow the included instructions to download the Qkr app, register your child/children, then make payment and complete forms by choosing the Year 7 Orientation Camp 2022 under the Activity tab. If you do not have a credit/debit card please call the office to obtain permission forms and an alternative payment method.

ACTIVITIES at the camp may include....

*Subject to weather and availability

ICE-BREAKER GAMES: Fun, short, basic level team building activities designed to break down barriers and get everyone working together. Exciting activities allowing teams to be creative in small or large groups. A great introduction towards team building activities or if a group is newly formed.

CAVING: Crawl 280m in the first artificial cave system built in Perth with qualified staff. In complete darkness, attempt Zorro's tunnel, the Maze as well as an underground tunnelling system. Head torches and helmets supplied.

FLYING FOX: Starting 5m up, zoom down two 80m long Flying Foxes. Jump off backwards, try X-Man or Cannonball. Confront your fears with our qualified staff.

ARCHERY: Using re-curve fibreglass bows, test your aim at hitting Olympic-style bullseye target boards. Along the way master your archery techniques. All equipment is provided.

ORIENTEERING: In over 28 hectares of coastal bushland use our maps to navigate to the 22 orienteering markers located within the Ern Halliday Recreation Camp. Will you have enough time to find them all?

BEACH TEAM BUILDING: Purpose designed for initiative beach activities without going into the water. Qualified instructors will run uniquely styled beach games with a splash or a difference. A great introduction into team building activities.

IPADS: In small groups students will use the iPad to make a movie trailer. These short clips will be shared with the year group at assemblies throughout the year.

QUIZ AND MOVIE NIGHT: Students will get to know each and test their brain power against their peers in this fun general knowledge quiz. Followed by a wind-down for the evening with a family friendly movie.
